
Venue and Travel

Travel to Bolzano/Bozen

Due to its geographical location, Bolzano/Bozen stands out as a major trade center in the Alpine region, accessible through a variety of transportation options.

Arriving by train

The Bolzano/Bozen train station is located in the town center, just a fifteen-minute walk from the Headquarters of Eurac Research and the main hotels.



The Train station is ~15 minutes on foot from Eurac Research



Train connections to major cities north and south of the Alps.

The primary railway route Bologna-Verona-Bolzano/Bozen-Brenner-Innsbruck-Munich facilitates quick access to all major urban centers in the region. Bolzano is well connected to many major European cities, including Paris, Berlin, Amsterdam, Zagreb, and Brussels, via night trains to Innsbruck or regional trains operated by ÖBB and Trenitalia to reach Bolzano.

Frequency of trains

Bolzano/Bozen boasts an extensive rail network that ensures excellent connectivity. Daily fast Eurocity trains provide swift access to Innsbruck and Munich, along with connections to Verona. High-speed trains provide direct services to major cities such as Milan, Trento, Venice, Bologna, Florence, Rome, Salerno, Naples, and Sibari, ensuring convenient travel across the country. Additionally, Intercity trains connect Bolzano/Bozen directly with Bari, Foggia, Pescara, and Rimini. For regional travel, hourly train services operate to and from Bolzano/Bozen, making it a key-hub for both long-distance and local journeys.

Arriving by plane

Fly to South Tyrol

South Tyrol's <u>Bozen Dolomiten regional airport</u> is located on the southern outskirts of the capital.

Sky Alps offers regular scheduled flights connecting several German cities, (including Düsseldorf, Berlin, Hamburg, Stuttgart) as well as from London and Copenhagen to Bolzano/Bozen. During the summer months, direct flights from Bolzano/Bozen Airport are also available to destinations such as Olbia, Cagliari, Catania, Lamezia Terme, and Brindisi.

The SASA city lines 10A and 10B provide frequent service between Bolzano Airport and the town center, as well as access to the bus and railway stations in Bolzano.

Taxi stands are conveniently located at the Bolzano railway station and the airport terminal, with a transfer time of approximately 15 minutes between the two locations.
