Brief background

Tier3 solutions GmbH is a company based in Germany which offers wildlife studies following the Good Laboratory Practice (GLP) Standard. This field season we are planning a study on small mammals in olive orchards in 3 areas in Campania. The objective of the study is to monitor the small mammal community in olive orchards with respect to the effects of pesticides used. The data will be used for the registration process of a product.

Job description

The working tasks will mainly include placing and checking live traps, data entry and check. Furthermore communication about the project with farmers is needed. There may also be other unforeseen tasks that arise within the post at various times. We are working six days a week for approximately 8 hours a day. Working schedule and workload need to stay flexible, depending on the field activities and field conditions.

Payment is €875 per week, plus travel expenses to/from field location. An accommodation close to the study fields is organised and paid by the company.

Personal requirements

The ideal candidate has experience with field work and small mammals. Working for many hours outside under sometimes harsh weather conditions should be acceptable. The candidate should work independently but also show flexibility in working as part of an international team.

Good command of written/spoken English and a full driving license are necessary and required.
